

## On approval of the list of categories of the population who are provided with palliative care and nursing care

Order of the Minister of Health and Social Development of the Republic of Kazakhstan dated February 25, 2015 No. 96. Registered with the Ministry of Justice of the Republic of Kazakhstan on March 30, 2015 No. 10576

In accordance with subparagraph 6) of paragraph 2 of Article 34 of the Code of the Republic of Kazakhstan dated September 18, 2009 "On the health of the people and the healthcare system" I ORDER:

- 1. Approve the attached list of categories of the population, which is palliative care and nursing care.
- 2. Department of Organization of Medical Care of the Ministry of Health and social development of the Republic of Kazakhstan to ensure:
  - 1) state registration of this order with the Ministry of Justice of the Republic of Kazakhstan;
- 2) within ten calendar days after the state registration of this an order in the Ministry of Justice of the Republic of Kazakhstan for official publication in periodicals and the information and legal system "Adilet";
- 3) posting this order on the Internet resource of the Ministry of Health and social development of the Republic of Kazakhstan.
- 3. To impose control over the execution of this order on the vice minister health care and social development of the Republic of Kazakhstan Tsoy A.V.
- 4. This order shall enter into force after ten calendar days from day of its first official publication.

List of population categories, who receive palliative care and nursing care

- 1. Palliative care is provided:
- 1) persons suffering from:

malignant neoplasms of the IV clinical group of dispensary observation; malignant neoplasms requiring drug correction

conditions after specialized treatment;

chronic progressive diseases in the terminal stage (stage decompensation of cardiac, pulmonary, hepatic, renal insufficiency);

tuberculosis registered at the dispensary in group 1G of dispensary registration;

acquired immunodeficiency syndrome stage 3-4;

- 2) children, with the progression of malignant neoplasms against the background of the specific therapy (chemotherapy, radiation therapy and surgical treatment);
- 3) children suffering from leukemia, with progression of the disease against the background of ongoing chemotherapy (chemoresistance).
  - 2. Nursing care is provided:

- 1) to the persons specified in paragraph 1 of this list;
- 2) persons completely or partially incapable of self-care, in need of constant extraneous care, help or supervision, absolutely dependent on other persons in providing vital social and household functions due to an illness.

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
